MONTHLY BOARD MEETING MINUTES April 12, 2023

The monthly board meeting for the Town of Greenwood was called to order by Chairman James Gebauer at 7:00 PM. All members of the board were present. Towns residents present included Doug Rabitoy, Chris & Meghan Birch, Andrea Peche, Mike Peters, and newly elected chairman, Mitch Peters.

Minutes – Minutes were read by Clerk Jill Scheithauer. A motion was made by Sup. Michael Wudi to accept the minutes from the March meeting; second by Sup. Travis Fuchs; motion passed.

Public Input – Doug, Chris and Meghan were present to issue a complaint about the brush cutting that was done on Hetland Avenue. Gebauer explained to them that the town has the right to cut from 33½ feet from the center of the road. They understood that but want the mess cleaned up. Meghan also added her concern about spraying pesticides due to her certifying as an organic produce grower. Fuchs agreed that a solution needs to be made to clean up the mess caused by the brush cutting. The board discussed options to clean up the mess. Andrea Peche was present to discuss her concerns about the 5G tower(s) being raised in the township.

Treasurer's Report / Pay Bills – A motion was made by Fuchs and seconded by Wudi to accept the treasurer's report and pay the bills. Motion passed. Treasurer Linda Bartelt ask the board about putting our money we currently have in savings into a money market account to earn more interest.

Road Updates – Flooding has caused issues. Both River Road and Timber Drive have been closed due to flooding. Fuchs advised that water is running over Tower Road as well as Wood Creek Avenue. Highway Commissioner Ben Stanfley is declaring Timber Drive a disaster project which allows us to qualify for funding to clean it up.

Gravel Bids – Haas Construction was the only bid submitted. ³/₄" quoted at \$13.50/yard. Town residents would be charged \$1 more per ton. \$13.50/yard = \$9/ton. Town residents would pay \$10/ton. Motion was made by Fuchs and second by Wudi to accept the only bid. Motion passed.

Dust Control – A quote was received from Kafka for dust control. Scheithauer inadvertently forgot it at home. Matter tabled until May's meeting. There is a possibility that the county may be getting a liquid form of dust control to use as an alternative option.

Other Business - None.

A motion was made by Fuchs and seconded by Wudi to adjourn the meeting at 7:50p.m. Next meeting to be held on May 10, 2023. Meeting adjourned.
