TOWN OF GREENWOOD MONTHLY BOARD MEETING MINUTES December 11, 2024

The monthly board meeting for the Town of Greenwood was called to order by Chairman Mitchell Peters at 7:04 PM. All members present.

Minutes - Minutes were read by Clerk Jill Scheithauer. A motion was made by Sup. Michael Wudi and seconded by Sup. Travis Fuchs to accept the minutes of the November meeting. Motion passed.

Treasurer's Report/Pay Bills – A motion was made by Travis to pay the bills and accept the treasurer's report. Second by Mike. Motion passed.

Public Input - None.

Road Updates – Graderman Kurt Bube had to replace the oil pan on the truck as it rusted out. The injector pump went out on the brush cutter. Travis asked Kurt if he could take the grader over River Road as there was an issue with a resident hauling some equipment causing large ruts in the road.

Graderman Wages – Travis makes a motion to increase graderman wages to \$29.50/hour effective January 1, 2025. Mike seconds. Motion passed.

Appoint Election Workers – Travis makes a motion to appoint the same election workers as last year. Mike seconds. Motion Passed.

Ordinance RE: Wellington Lake Drive – deferred from the November meeting. Currently the town has an ordinance placing WLD as a Class B road. The board was looking for clarification of the ordinance in place as there was a milk truck traveling up and down WLD that was causing concern about being overweight.

Other Business – Travis questioned the number of buildings being built in the town where building permits have not been completed. Some discussion was had about the topic. Town assessor to be made aware of any known buildings that are being/have been built. Jill requested a new bulletin board be purchased to display all election information separately inside the town hall. Request approved.
